**Musical notes:** The arrangement is for assembly, keyboard and flute. Chord symbols for guitarists have also been provided. The flute part need not accompany every verse and refrain; instead, the flautist can support the assembly by playing the melody.

**Text:** The verses are a paraphrase of verses 1, 10, 13-15, 27-28 and 33-34 of Psalm 103(104).

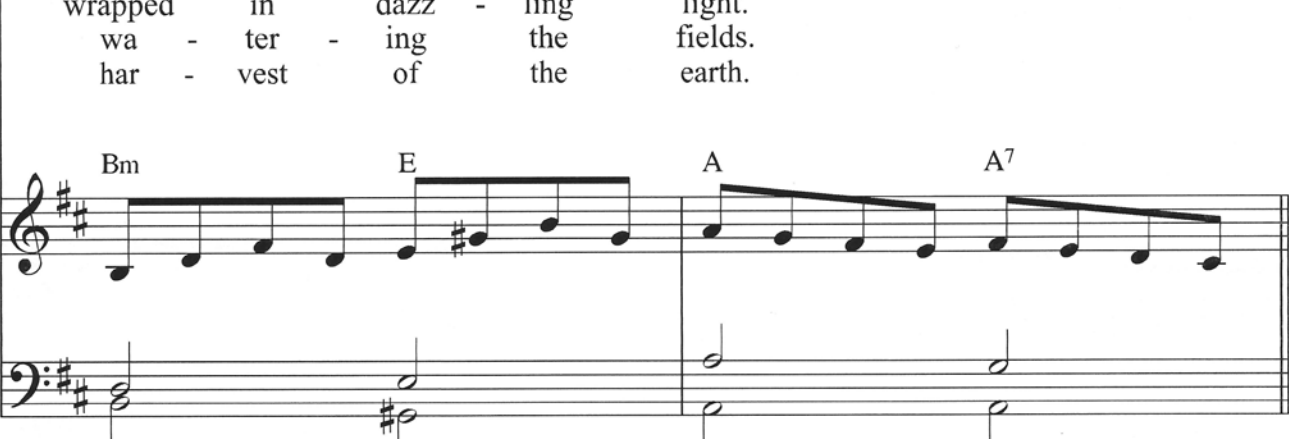

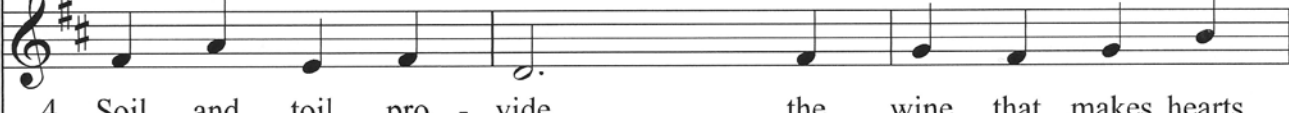

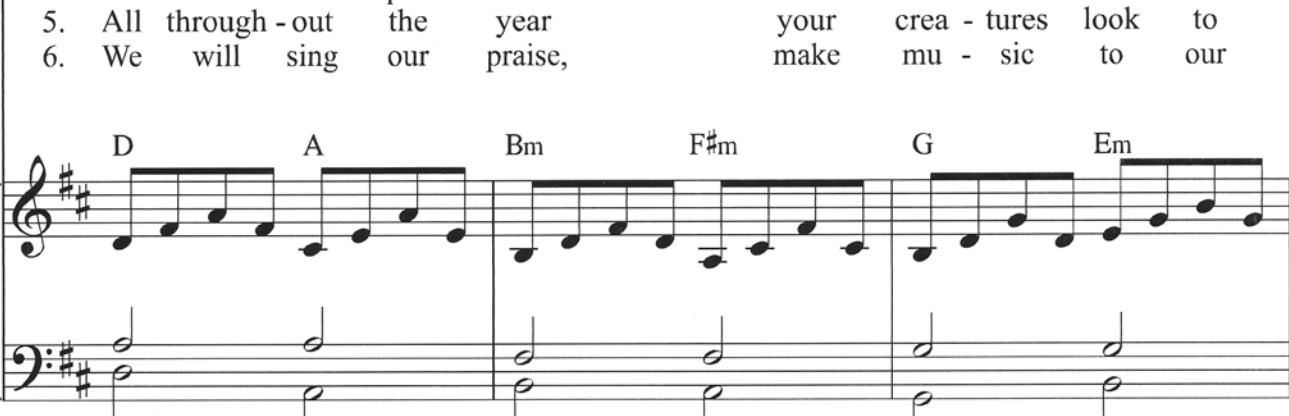
